

COVID Precaution Procedures for MWBC 2021

Sanitizing:

- Make hand-sanitizer readily available.
 - o Dining Hall
 - o Nurses Station
 - o Cabins
- Increased sanitizing efforts should be performed by assigned adults to ensure it is accomplished at the proper times and in the proper way.
 - o Once a day
 - Cabins (these need to be kept clean)
 - Class locations and equipment
 - Sports shed, sports equipment
 - Canteen: wipe down the counter between service to campers
 - o Often
 - Tables
 - Common areas used throughout the day
 - o Directors should reinforce & encourage good hygiene throughout the week

Person to Person Interaction:

- Temperatures will be taken at registration
- No masks will be required
- Nurses will be supplied with: face shields, face masks & gloves
- Directors will be encouraged to keep group sizes small and keep campers outside as much as possible.
- No coming and going during camp sessions will be allowed.
 - o Once the gate closes at end of registration, it stays closed (figuratively), this includes staff.
 - o Exceptions will be made for medical emergencies.
 - o 2 staff members should be designated by the director to make runs to town as needed. Please limit trips to town to as few as needed
 - o No outside visitors during any session.
 - o Parents/visitor's night will be canceled for this year.
- Canteen staff should be limited to 3 people. They should wear gloves and wipe down the serving counter between campers.

Suspected/Detected COVID infection protocol:

- Quarantine the individual. A cabin will need to be kept empty for the purposes of quarantining.
- Have the individual rapid tested and keep them isolated until results come in.
- While the individual is quarantined:
 - o Contact parents
 - o Directors and relevant staff will need to make a determination if quarantined camper was in close proximity (<3 feet) for a longer time (>15 minutes) and notify parents of exposed campers.
 - o Notify the parents of the other campers in the cabin
 - o If COVID test is positive, the camper should be picked up ASAP

Dining Hall/Meal procedures:

- All tables, benches, and common areas will be sanitized before and after meals.
- Plastic silverware/napkin packets will be used at meals instead of pre-setting tables with these items.
- The salad bar and self serve items will be eliminated and single serve items/containers will be used. These items will be prepared in advance of meals and available for pick up in the serving line. All meal items will be served by a staff member. (serving gloves will be worn)
- Drinks will not be set out on tables for self service. Drinks will be poured ahead of meal time and picked up when moving through the serving line.

- When clearing tables after meals, plates will not be passed down to the end of the table and handled by everyone. Instead, a bowl will be placed on every table for each person to scrape their plates into.
- Trash cans will be set up down the center isle of the dining hall and at each door so that each person can throw away their own trash after meals.
- Dining tables will be set up in the traditional way, creating a center isle and leaving room for each table to be walked around.
- KP will wear gloves while cleaning up and handling things after meals.
- No-touch water bottle filler fountains will be utilized instead of using the large water jugs.
