

# SALT (Servant Attitude Leadership Training)

## Application for 2020

\*Application only needed for SALT I. Once you complete SALT I successfully, no additional application is needed for SALT II.

**S.A.L.T.** is a leadership program for teens in grades 10-12. This program is designed to train the future leaders of Christian camping. Participants will complete the program by progressing through 2 weeks of training over 2 summers. The first week (SALT I) is held during Junior Week. This week focuses on counselor training. The second week (SALT II) is held during Intermediate Week. This week focuses on developing leadership skills, explores service in other camp staff positions, and provides further instruction in counseling. Entrance into the program is determined after an application, reference, and acceptance process is completed.

To apply for participation in the SALT program, please fill out the **application** below. Make sure that you list **two references** from either your **home congregation** or from the **Board of Directors of MWBC**. You only need to submit this application before participating in SALT I. With the approval of this application, you will be accepted to participate in SALT I and II, provided you successfully complete SALT I.

There is a **\$80 fee** to attend SALT I or SALT II. (This applications should be received by **May 16th** to be considered for the program. In addition, don't forget to fill out the **regular MWBC camper application** where you will select attendance at SALT I or II. The SALT application should be sent to the SALT I director. (see the info. on the bottom of pg. 2) Send the regular camp application to the address on the application.

A major part of your training is experience based, so you will spend the majority of your time among campers and will also stay in a cabin with campers while being mentored by mature counselors.

We feel it is best to limit your outside distractions during this important time of preparation in the ministry of Christian camping.
